



GTH Chromebook PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

Before a device can be issued to students for school and home use, parents must sign the Policy Agreement

Note: The purchase of an additional protective carrying case is highly recommended as it will protect the Chromebook from accidental damage. Specially designed sleeves or bags may be available for purchase through your child's school.

The parent/guardian is responsible for the cost of repair or replacement of the Chromebook if it is intentionally damaged, lost because of negligence, or stolen but not reported to school and the police.

Parents are encouraged to provide a safe environment for students to use their Chromebooks at home for school assignments. A Wi-Fi Internet connection will be required for the majority of Chromebook use; however, some applications, such as Google Docs, can be used while not connected to the Internet. Parents/Guardians are also encouraged to:

- Set rules for student use at home.
- Allow use in common areas of the home where student use can easily be monitored.
- Demonstrate a genuine interest in student's use of device.
- Reinforce the idea that the device is a productivity tool to support learning, rather than used as a form of entertainment.

GTH Chromebook Policy, Procedures & Information Handbook

This handbook serves as a resource for both students and parents. Parents and students must read this handbook and then agree to comply with the requirements contained within the handbook.

The completed form will be collected at the time of Chromebook distribution. Chromebooks will not be distributed to a student without the parent's signature.

I acknowledge both my student and I agree to all terms outlined in the Green Tech High Charter Student Handbook.

I understand my child is responsible for his actions with technology resources owned by the Green Tech High Charter School.

- My student understands to be careful with his device, and to tell an adult if something happens to the device, or the device is lost. There will be a 50.00 repair fee for any damage outside of normal wear and tear that may not be covered by the insurance fee. Loss of or replacement of the charger will incur a 25.00 fee. If the device is stolen, a police report must be filed by the parent and turned into the school office. **Loss is not covered. Green Tech High Charter School will require student/parent to pay a replacement cost of up to \$200.00, if the device is lost, stolen, or damaged beyond repair within the scope of the insurance.**

- If a student is having a software/hardware issue, please contact techsupport@greentechhigh.org.

My student has no expectation of privacy with any usage of the device. The school may, without prior notice or consent, log, supervise, access, view, monitor, and record use at any time and for any reason.

I understand my student will have their Internet access monitored. A “filter” will be applied to their Internet browsing to block inappropriate content. However, no filtering technology is perfect and inappropriate content may still be viewable. The final responsibility to avoid inappropriate websites rests with my child.

Any violations of this agreement and/or procedure may result in my student having to return the device to the School. I will assure the device is returned at the end of the school year. I will turn the device in No later than June 30th 2022 or I will pay \$200.00 to Green Tech High Charter. If I should un-enroll my child, I will return the device within 72 hours of the student un-enrolling from Green Tech High, or as requested by the School. Failure to return the device when requested will result in appropriate disciplinary and/or legal action.

Accepting this device means that my child is fully responsible for completing all his work online as assigned to him by Green Tech High. If I do not accept this device, it means that I have a device and my child is also fully responsible for completing all work assigned by Green Tech High Charter School.

By signing the Chromebook Policy & Procedure Agreement, you commit to the student expectations and understand the consequences for violations.
